The following items are included:



Assembly (see page 2 and 3)

Assemble the rod to the base (1) and the height regulator to the rod (2).

Then assemble the tool fixation for to the fume extractor tube (3).

Insert the fume extractor tube into the opening of the height regulator (4) until its end comes out on the back side. Afterwards assemble the flexible hose to the fume extractor tube (5).

Fix ALE250 by means of the tool fixation to the fume extractor tube (6) and connect it with the control unit (7).


Finally connect the flexible hose to your filter and suction pump (8) and the pedal to the control unit at its rear side (9).

Features

ALI Handsfree Stand is ideal for those applications requiring to have both hands free, like cable soldering or connector assembly.


The handsfree stand is used with ALE250 Automatic Feed Soldering Iron and to have both hands free must also be used and connected P405 Pedal to ALE control unit.

The handsfree stand incorporates a fume extraction system to suck the fume generated during soldering. Its fume extraction hose must be connected to an required extraction pump with filter.
